Dear Parents and Guardians,

ARK (Assessment of Religious Knowledge) is a web based formative assessment for grades 2 through 12 that assesses Catholic Religious Knowledge of both students and teachers. ARK allows schools to see how individual students are learning across these grade levels questions linked to six domains of the Faith to better assess Catholic Identity and culture. The six domains are:

- Creed & Salvation History
- Living Discipleship
- Prayer
- Morality
- Sacraments & Liturgy
- Virtues

The assessment will take place "TBD between March 18- May 3rd". It will be administered to all students across the Diocese of Harrisburg Catholic Schools during the Spring. Here is a link to review sample questions and information regarding ARK: Home-Assessment of Religious Knowledge (arktest.org)
