



Pax City, is our CCCS middle school town where our students learn about how society works while also building valuable life skills. On the first day of school, students worked together in a town meeting to determine the town rules and mission statement. The students then entered the town through a citizenship test based on the rules they created.

As citizens, students learned about writing resumes and participated in individual interviews, competing against their town mates for jobs at the town company, Pax Co. Students work daily on their job tasks and earn PC bucks (PC\$) to spend at the Pax Co. Store. These are hot ticket items that students determined.

Twice a week, students come together for town meetings, where they discuss issues at school, work together to determine how they can be of service to the town of Chambersburg, and learn how to be a middle school community. Right now, the students are creating service projects based on the Corporal Works of Mercy. In the future, the town will add a student government and a peer court system to resolve peer-to-peer conflicts.
